Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** and discuss other business items. The following meetings are scheduled during November 2010:

Technical Coordinating Committee—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on **Tuesday, November 2nd, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Citizens Advisory Committee—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet **Tuesday, November 2nd, 2010 at 2:00 p.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the policy board of local elected and appointed officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on **Thursday, November 4th, 2010 at 11:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

1. **Project Number ST-24-AM:** The proposed project is as follows: Funds for Displaced Workers Recruitment Program to provide highway construction hands on experience and or on the job training (OJT). The total cost of the project is \$262,892 total dollars. The project is 100% federal funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
2. **Project Number ST-25-AM:** Resurface and 2' safety widening on SR-14 from SR-143 to west end of Calloway Creek. The project scope is for maintenance and a two foot safety widening. The project length is 2.75 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$821,866. The project is 100% state funded. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
3. **Project Number NHS-20-AM:** Resurface SR-21 (US-231) from the end of the 4 lane at Wallsboro to 0.5 miles north of CR-667. The project scope is for maintenance. The project length is 4.36 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$1,064,866 total dollars with \$851,892 in federal funds and \$212,973 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
4. **Project Number E-14-AM:** The previously approved project of paving the shoulders and traffic stripping on Redland Road from Rifle Range Road to Marshall Rd is being changed to the following project description as follows: Pave shoulder and traffic stripe on Redland Rd from Firetower Rd to Marshall Rd. The project scope is for construction. The project length is 1.5 miles of roadway. The previously approved dollar amount for the original project description was \$441,869 total dollars (\$353,495 in federal dollars and \$88,373.75 in matching funds. The total cost of the revised project is \$204,750 total dollars with \$163,800 in federal funds and \$40,950 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.
5. **Project Number E-15-AM:** Corridor Study for Redland Road (CR-8) from US-231 (SR-9) to Rifle Range Rd (CR-4) for the purpose of adding additional roadway capacity and intersection improvements. The project scope is preliminary engineering. The total cost of the project is \$237,119 total dollars with \$189,695 in federal funds and \$47,424 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.
6. **Project Number P-10-AM:** Resurface Wetumpka St from N. Washington Street to US-31 (Memorial Dr.). The project scope is construction. The project length is 1.09 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$250,000 total dollars with \$200,000 in federal funds and \$50,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Prattville.
7. **Project Number P-11-AM:** Resurface Sheila Blvd. from East Main St. to US-31 (Memorial Dr.). The project scope is construction. The project length is 1.40 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$250,000 total dollars with \$200,000 in federal funds and \$50,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Prattville.
8. **Project Number P-12-AM:** Resurface S. McQueen Smith Rd from East Main St. to US-82. The project scope is construction. The project length is 1.41 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$250,000 total dollars with \$200,000 in federal funds and \$50,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Prattville.
9. **Project Number E-16-AM:** Widening roadway width from ten feet to twelve feet, level, resurface, and traffic stripe on Balm Rd. (CR-49) from SR-9 to Peterson Creek. The project scope is for construction. The project length is 3.5 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$577,500 total dollars with \$462,000 in federal funds and \$115,500 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.

10. **Project Number E-17-AM:** Widen roadway width from ten feet to twelve feet, level, and resurface Deatsville Hwy (CR-7) from Millbrook City limits to SR-143. The project scope is for construction. The project length is 5.6 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$868,000 total dollars with \$694,400 in federal funds and \$173,600 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.
11. **Project Number DEM-2-AM:** Sidewalk Rehabilitation on the campus of Alabama State University. The project scope is for preliminary engineering and construction. The total cost of the project is \$245,982 total dollars with \$32,420 for preliminary engineering and \$213,562 for construction. The project is a demonstration project 100% federally funded. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
 - **MPO Transportation Planning Staff will give a staff assessment of where the new 2010 Montgomery urbanized area will be located based on the proposed Census Bureau 2010 Proposed Criteria.**
 - **MPO Staff will also discuss the kick-off of an update of the Montgomery MPO Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan document for fiscal years 2011-2015.**
