Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** and discuss other business items. The following meetings are scheduled during March 2011:

Technical Coordinating Committee—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on **Tuesday, March 15th, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Citizens Advisory Committee—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet **Tuesday, March 15th, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the policy board of local elected and appointed officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for the adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on **Thursday, March 17th, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room. **NOTE: The time has been changed from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00a.m.**

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

1. **Project Number E-18-AM:** Widen, Level, Resurface, Traffic Stripe and Shoulder paving on Coosada Parkway from Alabama River Parkway to Coosada Road. This project is proposed to increase from \$599,000 to \$798,000, a total increase of \$199,000, to cover increased construction costs. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$798,000 total dollars with \$638,400 in federal funds and \$159,600 in matching funds. The project length is 3.2 miles. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.
2. **Project Number HHP-9-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop north of I-85 interchange. Phase 3; grade, drain, base, pave, bridge on relocation SR-126; widen I-85 Southbound bridge over Millies Creek; and Grade portions of ramps 1 and 2. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$15,873,145 total dollars with \$12,698,516 in federal funds and \$3,174,629 in matching funds. The project length is 0.11 miles. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
3. **Project Number HHP-10-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop from south of SR-110 thru I-85 interchange. Phase 5; BSP Outer Loop, service road, ramps at SR-110 interchange and I-85 interchange. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$17,576,912 total dollars with \$14,061,530 in federal funds and \$3,515,382 in matching funds. The project length is 2.9 miles. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
4. **Project Number HHP-11-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop from SR-110 to I-85 Interchange (Phase II). Bridge on US-80 Relocation; widen I-85 Northbound Bridge; GDP I-85 Northbound; GDR portions of ramps 3 and 4; GDP US-80 relocation (GPB)grade, drain, base, pave & bridge. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$20,462,194 total dollars with \$16,513,755 in federal funds and \$4,128,438 in matching funds. The project length is 2.79 miles. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
5. **Project Number HHP-12-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop (SR-108) at I-85 interchange ramp bridges. Phase 4, Ramp Bridges 1, 2, 3 and 4 substructure; SR-110; Millies Creek. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$26,733,820 total dollars with \$21,387,056 in federal funds and \$5,346,765 in matching funds. The project length is 0.43 miles. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
6. **Project Number HHP-13-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop (SR-108) at I-85 interchange ramp bridges. Phase 4A, Ramp Bridges 1, 2, 3 and 4 substructure. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$49,435,348 total dollars with \$39,548,278 in federal funds and \$9,887,069 in matching funds. The project length is 0.43 miles. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.

7. **Project Number NHS-21-AM:** Resurface SR-6 (US-82) from SR-3 (US-31) to CR-875 (Cobbs Ford Road). The project scope is for federal maintenance for a total cost of \$1,717,000 total dollars with \$1,373,600 being federal dollars and \$343,400 in matching funds. Project length is 2.19 miles. The State of Alabama is the project sponsor.
