Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** and discuss other business items. The following meetings are scheduled during January 2011:

Technical Coordinating Committee—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on **Tuesday, January 18th, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Citizens Advisory Committee—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet **Tuesday, January 18th, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the policy board of local elected and appointed officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on **Thursday, January 20th, 2011 at 11:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

1. **Project Number TE-10-AM:** Pedestrian Sidewalks along SR-9 (US-231) on Ft. Toulouse Road (from the Post Office to Elmore County's recently-developed bike trail) in the City of Wetumpka. The total cost of the project is \$168,000 total dollars with \$134,400 in federal funds and \$33,600 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
2. **Project Number TR-8-AM:** Section 5310 Transit funds for the City of Wetumpka to purchase a Capital Vehicle. The total cost of the project is \$47,087 total dollars with \$37,670 in federal funds and \$9,417 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
3. **Project Number TR-9-AM:** Section 5310 Transit funds for the Montgomery County Commission to purchase a Capital Purchased Transportation. The total cost of the project is \$37,500 total dollars with \$30,000 in federal funds and \$7,500 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
4. **Project Number TR-10-AM:** Section 5317 New Freedom funds for the Easter Seals of Central Alabama for fiscal year 2011 Senior Services. The total cost of the project is \$69,400 total dollars with \$55,520 in federal funds and \$13,880 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
5. **Project Number TR-11-AM:** Section 5316 Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) funds for the Easter Seals of Central Alabama for fiscal year 2011 Senior Services. The total cost of the project is \$66,000 total dollars with \$33,000 in federal funds and \$33,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
6. **Project Number M-50-AM:** Resurface and add bicycle lanes to Congressman W.L. Dickinson Dr. from the CSX railroad to 0.23 miles south of Northern Blvd. The project scope is for preliminary engineering and construction for a total cost of \$3,125,000 total dollars with \$2,500,000 being federal dollars and \$625,000 in matching funds. Project length 2.0 miles. The City of Montgomery is the project sponsor.
7. **Project Number M-51-AM:** Delete project for resurfacing, landscaping and converting oneway to twoway on Clay and Herron Street. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$1,015,462 total dollars with \$812,370 being federal dollars and \$203,092 in matching funds. Project length is 0.75 miles. The City of Montgomery is the project sponsor.
