SUMMARY OF PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT ACTIVITIES

The Montgomery MPO Transportation Planning Staff held a two week public comment period from August 19, 2009 through September 1, 2009 to solicit comments from the general public regarding the Draft 2010 Unified Planning Work Program. The MPO Transportation Planning Staff reviewed the Draft 2010 Unified Planning Work Program at the August 11, 2009 Technical Coordinating Committee meeting, the August 11, 2009 Citizens Advisory Committee meeting, and the August 12, 2009 MPO meeting. After the MPO Staff explained the draft FY-2010 UPWP, the TCC, CAC, and MPO members present at each respective meeting discussed the document and asked the MPO staff questions.

3. **Project Number M-14-AM:** Resurface Court Street from Fairview Avenue to the Southern Blvd. The project length is approximately 1.72 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$2,000,000. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.
4. **Project Number IM-1-AM:** Retrofit and repair bridge joints on I-65 between the Montgomery County line to South of State Route 6 (US Highway 82 at Exit 179). The project length is 2.28 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$432,640. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
5. **Project Number HHP-5-AM:** Phase three of Montgomery Outer Loop. Project location is north of I-85 interchange at Montgomery Outer Loop I-85 interchange. Grade, drain, base, pave and bridge on relocation of State Route 126; widen I-85 Southbound bridge over Millies Creek; and grade portions of ramps 1 and 2. The project length is 0.11 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$15,335,836. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.

7. **Project Number E-5-AM:** Shoulder widening on County Road 4 from County Road 8 (Redland Road) to County Road 234 (Mitchell Creek Road). The project length is 6.61 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$476,911. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
8. **Project Number TE-1-AM:** Sidewalk construction on southern side of Chapman Road from the intersection of Chapman Road and Main Street East to the Millbrook City School entrance. The project length is 0.45 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$99,475. The project sponsor is the City of Millbrook.
9. **Project Number TE-2-AM:** Landscaping along State Route 271 (Taylor Road) at Auburn University Montgomery property. The project length is 0.25 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$12,972. The project sponsor is the Auburn University of Montgomery.
