Outreach Results:

To date, comments on the draft 2030 LRTP have been received from 3 citizens. Responses have been developed to address comments and a summary of public comments is also underway. Copies of the responses and comment forms will also be forwarded to the Montgomery Area MPO once the letters are finalized. Comments received include:

- Opposition to the widening of Woodley Road, Fairview Avenue and Mulberry Street
- Improvements to Old Farm Lane in Elmore County are not justified based on 2030 build conditions
- No build projects for roads in the City of Millbrook. CR 7 and CR 3 should be reevaluated base4d on projected growth
- Reduce number of four and three way stop signs
- Build modern interchanges at our interstates and major highway junctions, i.e. South Blvd and I-65
- Build overpasses at major intersections, i.e. South Blvd. and Troy Highway or East Blvd. and Vaughn Road
- Widen Ann St. Zelda Road, Perryn Hill Road
- More east-west and north-south connections that are closer together
