

**Technical Summary for the Draft Congestion Management System Plan**  
**Draft Fiscal Years (FY) 2009-2013 Congestion Management System Plan Update**  
**(CMSP)**

1. **Transportation Public Involvement Summary**-The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that an Updated Draft FY 2009-2013 CMSP is available for public review and comment. The Updated Draft FY 2009-2013 CMS is a transportation congestion management system plan for the three county transportation study area. The CMS's companion plan's, as required by the United States Department of Transportation, are the 20-25 Year *Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)* and short range *Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)*.
2. **Background**-Each of the 13 urban areas in Alabama is required to have a transportation planning process in order to receive Federal Highway and Transit Capital or Operating Assistance. The CMSP is a short range review of documented existing and future traffic congestion with strategies to manage congestion in the MPO transportation study area. The Montgomery transportation study area receives about \$4 million per year in federal transportation funding that are used for transportation purposes. Additionally, other federal funds are spent by the Alabama Department of Transportation for transportation purposes. Some transportation projects are implemented in order to maintain the transportation system and some are implemented for congestion management and safety reasons.
