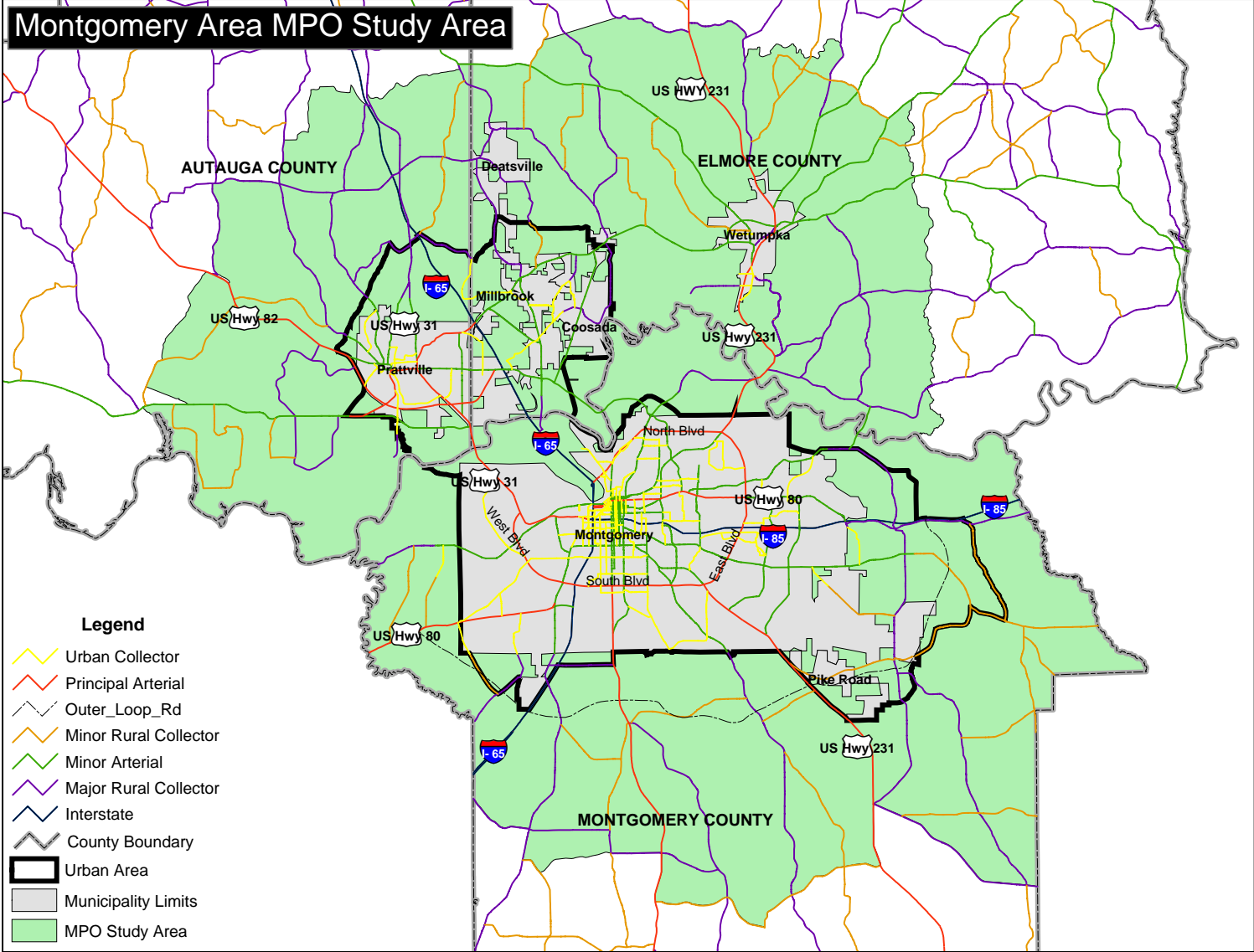

TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FISCAL YEARS 2006-2008

Introduction

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a list of transportation projects developed by the Montgomery Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). The 12-member MPO has elected representatives from the Town of Coosada, the City of Millbrook, the City of Montgomery, the City of Prattville, and the City of Wetumpka, as well as County Commission representatives for Autauga, Elmore, and Montgomery Counties. The Alabama Department of Transportation Sixth Division Engineer and the City of Montgomery Director of Planning and Development also serve on the MPO as voting members. The MPO non-voting members also contribute to the planning process. The projects in the TIP are taken from the *Montgomery Study Area 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan* with the exception of safety, resurfacing, and few other special types of projects. In most cases, the *2030 Long Range Transportation Plan* projects must be done in phases through the TIP.

The Safe Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Act – A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) requires TIPs to be fiscally constrained. This means that the MPO cannot put in more projects in the TIP than it can fund. In the past, the Montgomery MPO received dedicated STP monies which were allocated on the basis of the Montgomery Urbanized Area having a population greater than 200,000. However, due to a Census Bureau change in the definition of what and where the urbanized area is and the total urbanized area population being below 200,000, the Montgomery Area stopped receiving dedicated monies at the end of FY-02. The ALDOT does provide Surface Transportation Program Other Area funds in lieu of dedicated funds based on the 2000 Census urbanized area population of 196,892 (resulting from the new definition of what the new Montgomery Urbanized Area is). The end result was that the change of definition reduced area-wide funding by about 10%. The MPO selects the highway and congestion management projects for carry over funds and ALDOT has the option of funding proposed projects that exceed the Other Area funding allocation or requiring the excess projects to be removed from the TIP in order to achieve fiscal constraint.

The City of Montgomery also receives Federal Transit Administration (FTA) formula and capital funds (Sections 5307 and 5309 respectively). Also, Autauga County also receives FTA Section 5311 funds for rural transportation in the area. The highway or transit project sponsor is responsible for providing the local match if local match is required.

The other projects shown in this TIP are State Discretionary Projects. They are as follows: Intelligent Transportation System (ITS), Bridge (BR), Interstate Maintenance (IM), National Highway System (NHS), State Surface Transportation Program (STP), Hazard Elimination and Safety (HES), STP Transportation Enhancement (TE), Other (OTH, and STP-Railroad (RR). The State also allocates FTA Section 5310 (vehicles for non-profits) and FTA Section 5311 (for rural public transportation). The Outer Loop Road in Montgomery is funded by Congressional allocation and is shown as a High Priority Program Project (HP).

LEVEL OF EFFORT

Projects in the FY 2006-2008 TIP, which are referred to as LEVEL OF EFFORT (LVOE), represent certain unidentified projects which will be authorized during a given fiscal year. These projects are placed in the TIP according to selected funding programs with their anticipated apportionments for each fiscal year within the TIP. The selected funding programs include:

- Transportation Enhancement Projects
- Safety Projects such as hazard elimination roadway and rail, high speed rail, seat belt, blood alcohol content, etc.
- Transportation and Community and System Preservation
- Recreational Trails
- Federal Aid Resurfacing Program
- GARVEE Bond Projects
- County Allocated Funds such as, off system bridge, optional bridge, and STP non urban
- Federal Transit Sections 5311 (non-urban), and 5310 (Elderly and Disabilities)

Any of these LVOE type projects are pre-approved by the MPO and will not require any further MPO action prior to authorization. The MPO's will be notified as soon as the specific projects within their urban areas are selected and will have five days to decline the project.

Planning Factors

TEA-21 identifies seven (7) areas to be considered in the transportation planning process, as follows:

1. Support the economic vitality of the metropolitan area, especially by enabling global competitiveness, productivity and efficiency.
2. Increase the safety and security of the transportation system for motorized and non-motorized users.
3. Increase the accessibility and mobility options available to people and for freight.
4. Protect and enhance the environment, promote energy conservation and improve the quality of life.
5. Enhance the integration and connectivity of the transportation system.
6. Promote efficient system management and operation.
7. Emphasize the preservation of the existing transportation system.

Methodology

The Montgomery MPO Transportation Planning Staff used estimated funding levels from the ALDOT's urban area funding availability report for the Surface Transportation Attributable program for the updated FY 2006-2008 TIP. Also, projects that were in the ALDOT's Comprehensive Project Management System (CPMS) and new Transportation Economic and Land Use System (TELUS) were consulted for projects that are planned and have Federal and State project numbers for FY 2007 and FY 2008.

On November 9, 2006 the ALDOT provided the MPO Transportation Planning Staff with an Urban Area Funding Availability Report (Federal Funding Only) projects list that was balanced with planned projects against anticipated funds for existing and future years. The list was generated from ALDOT's CPMS.

On November 10-14, 2006 the MPO Transportation Planning Staff continued work to prepare the updated FY 2006-2008 TIP using ALDOT's TELUS and the

Urban Area Funding Availability Report. The TELUS is an internet based program that interfaces with the ALDOT CPMS and automatically updates when ALDOT's CPMS is modified. The Urban Area Funding Availability Report is derived from the CPMS.

Amendment Procedures

The FY 2006-2008 TIP document can and will be amended periodically, to adjust funding, time-frames or other factors relevant to projects. New projects may be added if appropriate and if funding is available.
